

Adding and Subtracting Decimals

- ① Line up the decimals
- ② If there are any empty spots, use a placeholder of zero.
- ③ Add or subtract
- ④ Bring Decimal straight down

Ex. $11.091 + 2.24$

$$\begin{array}{r} 11.091 \\ + 02.240 \\ \hline 13.331 \end{array}$$

Ex. $4.32 - 2.778$

$$\begin{array}{r} 34.320 \\ - 2.778 \\ \hline 1.542 \end{array}$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 1.001 \\ - 1.027 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

check answer w/ calculator
